

Children’s Trust Fund (CTF) Guidance for Place-Based Work with Families

Children’s Trust Fund (CTF) programs, staff, and families served have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Programs have shifted from place-based services to online or teleservices to continue to deliver the model programs with fidelity. Highlighted below are information links regarding the transition of services from online/teleservice to place-based services. Each organization will develop its own policies and procedures with consideration for Pennsylvania state-issued and local direction/mandates, funder requirements, and model program guidance.
